On Wednesday 4 July and Thursday 5 July, we will be hosting our first ever Performing Arts Festival at Wollaston School and we are delighted to announce that tickets are now available on Parentpay.

'Wollasfest!' promises to be an evening of entertainment and fun with a timetable of Drama, Dance and Music performances throughout the evening allowing you to move between the venues to watch the pieces that you choose. Alongside this, there will be face painting, a bouncy castle, photo booth and the opportunity to learn a song on a Ukulele!

The entrance and exit for this event will be at the gates towards the 6th Form end of the school and they will open at 6.30pm prior to the first performance which will take place in the Main Hall at 7.00pm. The final event of the evening will be a live music set in the courtyard outside the Performing Arts block (weather permitting) with the event finishing at approximately 10.30pm

There will also be the opportunity to purchase food and soft drinks from our school catering team who are going to be running a barbeque throughout the evening, serving burgers, hotdogs and several other items; a vegetarian option will also be available.

We endeavour to keep the ticket cost of as low as possible; any money raised at the event will be reinvested to buy new equipment and support future Performing Arts activities at Wollaston School.
